GUIDELINES:

- Students in Grade 10 are required to take 8 courses.
- In order to graduate with the OSSD, students must have a total of 30 credits (18 compulsory + 12 elective)
- If possible, students should select courses they are interested in that also satisfy the Group 1, 2 and 3 category requirements (if they have not vet achieved them).

Group 1: An additional credit in French as a second language, or a classical or international language, or social sciences and the humanities, or Canadian and world studies.

Group 2: An additional credit in health and physical education, or the arts, or business studies, or French as a second language

Group 3: An additional credit in science (Grade 11 or 12), or technological education, or French as a second language, or computer studies.
