Covid -19 Case at CPC

Dear Crestwood Preparatory College Community:

This evening we were notified that one of our grade ten students tested positive for Covid-19 today. This student has not been at school since last Thursday, October 1st, 2020. The family has followed all protocol, and the student will now be isolating at home for fourteen days.

Students and staff who were in potentially close contact with the student have been notified and will also be quarantining until October 15th and will be able to return to class on October 16th. The two teachers that day have also been alerted and will remain home under quarantine. They will now do all their teaching online.

All we can ask you to do is to continue to monitor situations carefully. The safety of our students is paramount. We are hopeful that this is an isolated case but are taking proactive measures to keep our school community safe and healthy.

We have advised Toronto Public Health; who are focusing on contact tracing. We are following their advice regarding Covid-19 procedures and protocols.

We wish the student a speedy recovery and hope that all members of the CPC Community remain well.
